

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to the 424 Treasure Dr. and Quick Signs Inc. and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to Quick Signs Inc. include 424 Treasure Dr. and Quick Signs. The Quick Signs website is a ecommerce site. By using the Quick Signs website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

Quick Signs may collect personally identifiable information, such as your name. If you purchase Quick Signs's products and services, we collect billing and credit card information. This information is used to complete the purchase transaction. We may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future.

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by Quick Signs. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Quick Signs website.

Quick Signs encourages you to review the privacy statements of websites you choose to link to from Quick Signs so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. Quick Signs is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on websites outside of the Quick Signs website.

Use of your Personal Information

Quick Signs collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested.

Quick Signs may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Quick Signs and its affiliates. Quick Signs may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Quick Signs does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

Quick Signs may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Quick Signs, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Quick Signs may keep track of the websites and pages our users visit within Quick Signs, in order to determine what Quick Signs services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within Quick Signs to customers whose behavior indicates that

they are interested in a particular subject area.

Quick Signs will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Quick Signs or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Quick Signs; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Quick Signs, or the public.

Use of Cookies

The Quick Signs website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Quick Signs pages, or register with Quick Signs site or services, a cookie helps Quick Signs to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same Quick Signs website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Quick Signs features that you customized.

Quick Signs secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other websites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) protocol.
